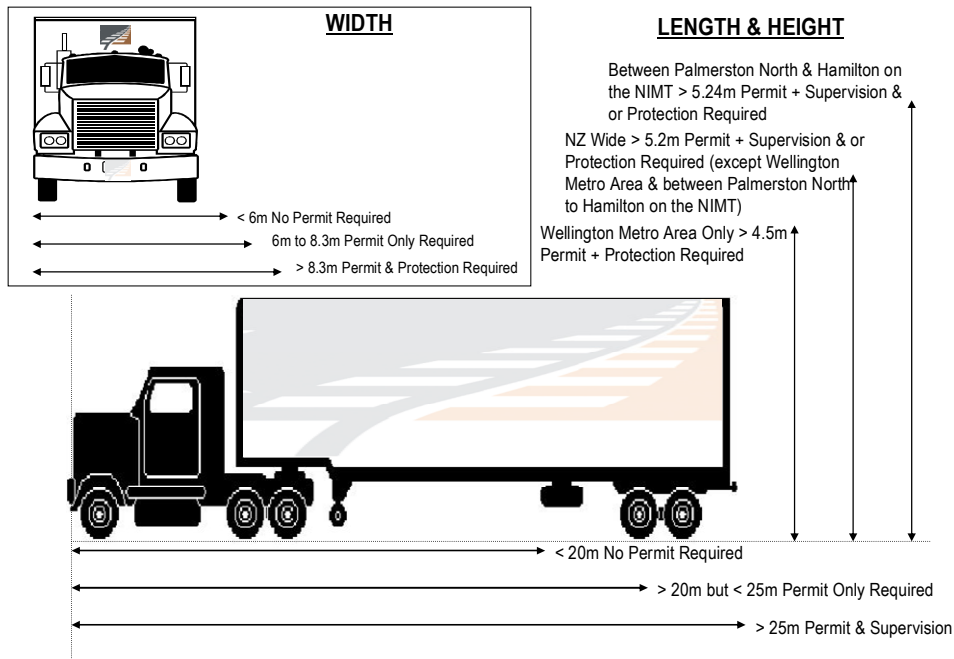

- The dimensions given in the table & diagrams above are a guide for public level crossings only. There are some Level Crossings that have safe dimensions less than that indicated in the above table. Road users who damage Ontrack equipment at Level Crossings will be billed for the cost of repair.
- In electrified areas the maximum overall height is not to exceed the height stated on the safe height sign.
- Supervision arrangements may be required to be put in place if dangerous goods are being carried.
- The need for a permit can be waived at the discretion of the permit issuer depending on local conditions and dimensions
